CORN, YELLOW

ACFB INGREDIENT NUMBER: CORN

CORNBULK

CORNFINE

CORNCOARSE

RCORNBULK

INTENDED USE: As a nutritional ingredient in the manufacture of feed for livestock

DEFINITION: Yellow Corn shall be any grain that consists of whole kernels of yellow,

shelled dent corn belonging to the family Zea mays

PHYSICAL PROPERTIES: Color: Yellow

Bulk Density:45 pounds per cubic foot

ANALYSIS:

Protein, min 7.0%

Fat, min 3.0%

Fiber, max 3.0%

Test Weight, min 54 lb/bu

Moisture, min 15.5%

CRITERIA FOR REJECTION: Not meeting any aspect of ingredient standards for U.S #2 grade

Moisture or heat damage or color change indicative of damage

Musty, rancid or sour odor

Presence of foreign material or insect infestation

More than 5% total damaged kernels

Note: Only CORNBULK is purchased, the other forms are processed in house.
