## SOYBEAN MEAL, DEHULLED

ACFB INGREDIENT NUMBER: SOY50

SOYLB

**INTENDED USE:** As a nutritional ingredient in the manufacture of feed for livestock

**DEFINITION:** Soybean meal, dehulled is produced by cracking, heating and flaking

soybeans and reducing the oil content of the conditioned product by the use of hexane or homologous hydrocarbon solvents to 1% or less on a commercial basis. It may contain an inert nontoxic conditioning agent, either nutritive or non-nutritive, or a combination thereof, to reduce caking

and improve flowability. Name of the conditioning agent must be shown

as an added ingredient on the label

PHYSICAL PROPERTIES: Color: Light tan to light brown

Odor: Fresh

Bulk Density:36-40 pounds per cubic foot

**ANALYSIS:** 

Protein, min 47.0%
Fat, min 1.0%
Fiber, max 3.3%
Moisture, max 12.0%

CRITERIA FOR REJECTION: Not meeting any aspect of ingredient standards

Moisture or heat damage or stains indicative of damage

Musty, moldy, sour or burnt odor

Presence of foreign material or insect infestation

Unground product

Excessive hull content
